



Press Release – 41 jobs saved as administrators rescue company.

All 41 jobs were recently saved after Electrical Installation Company Connect ES Limited was placed in to Administration on the 4 January 2017. The organisation’s headquarters which was based in Chichester, was experiencing severe financial difficulties before a corporate rescue process initiated by Joint Administrators Julie Swan and Mark Phillips, partners at PCR, helped rescue the company from the brink of collapse. The sale of the business took place a little over a week later and was completed on the 12 January 2017.

Consequently, all 41 permanent members of staff at Connect ES Limited were transferred across to the purchasing company Radlec Limited under the transfer of undertakings (Protection of Employment Regulations Act 2006).

Julie Swan of PCR said, “We are delighted that we have been able to help retain the continued employment of staff following our appointments, as well as providing the best positive outcome for its creditors”.
